Georgia's Strategic Industries Workforce Development Grant: An Edge for Economic Development

The skills gap that exists within the U.S. has not exempted Georgia. Within five years, more than 60 percent of jobs in our state will require a college certificate or degree, but currently, only 42 percent of the state's young adults have them.

Under Governor Deal's leadership, however, Georgia is taking an aggressive, multi-faceted approach, partnering with state agencies as well as private organizations and businesses to find solutions that ensure a workforce pipeline for Georgia companies. As the state's top resource for workforce, TCSG is proud to be a part of the network of public and private partners addressing the skills gap.

The Strategic Industry Workforce Development Grant (SIWDG) program is one solution that directly addresses specific workforce needs.
