Savannah Technical College is continuously seeking qualified candidates for adjunct faculty teaching positions. Adjunct faculty positions are temporary, part-time positions of employment appointed on a per academic term basis. Day and Evening hours available.

Qualifications:

Qualifications for instructional positions include a minimum of three years' full-time work experience in the discipline taught and educational background specific to the courses/programs. Formal teaching certification is not required. Teaching positions in most Associate Degree programs require a Master's Degree in the field (or) a Master's Degree in a related field with at least 18 semester hours in the subject to be taught.

Limited instructional opportunities are available in the Industrial Technology Division for candidates who possess an Associate's or Bachelor's Degree in the teaching discipline or a related field. However, preference will be given to candidates with a Master's Degree. All academic credentials must be granted by a nationally or regionally accredited college or university. In addition to education and work experience, some positions may also require active licensure or certification specific to the field. Compensation is commensurate with academic preparation and experience.
