Description:

Savannah Technical College is continuously seeking part-time, adjunct instructors to teach Sociology classes. Adjunct faculty positions are temporary, part-time positions of employment appointed on a per academic term basis. Day and evening hours are available. Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Instructing students, developing program syllabi, goals, and objectives
- evaluating students' progress in attaining goals and objectives
- ensuring student learning outcomes are attained and properly recorded
- preparing and maintaining all required documentation and administrative reports
- maintaining knowledge of current trends and developments in the field by attending staff development training, workshops, seminars and conferences
- ensuring safety and security requirements are met in the classroom area
- meeting with students, staff members, and other educators to discuss students' instructional programs and other issues impacting the progress of students

Duties include a flexible schedule of lecture and student advisement. Must be willing to work split teaching shifts that might require split teaching days between campus locations. Must fully embrace the responsibility for maintaining an acceptable number of students within this program and also work diligently to maximize student placements in this field or related fields by working directly with local employers and the Department of Labor.

Minimum Qualifications

- Master's degree in Sociology; or a Master's degree with 18 graduate semester hours in Sociology courses from a regionally accredited institution.
- One year of full-time (or equivalent), paid teaching experience.
- Excellent Leadership, human-relations, interpersonal skills, and strong verbal and written communication skills.
- Demonstrated skills in usage of Microsoft Office Suite.

Preferred Qualifications

- Preference will be given to those candidates who possess a terminal degree in Sociology, and also to those candidates who have been credentialed to teach, and have taught Sociology at a regionally accredited collegiate/university level.
- Candidate selected must be willing to obtain further graduate level coursework as necessary to meet articulation and/or accreditation requirements.
- Three years of full-time, paid teaching experience
- Active participation in appropriate professional/occupational organizations

Physical Demands

Work is typically performed in a classroom environment with intermittent sitting or walking in various settings. The employee occasionally lifts or moves objects of a light to medium weight.
