**Description:** South Georgia Technical College is seeking qualified applicants for the position of Aviation Maintenance Technology Program Instructor. In addition, the successful applicant will advise students in the Aviation Maintenance Technology program and participate in institutional activities. Must be student oriented and customer friendly. All other duties as assigned.

**Minimum Qualifications:** FAA Mechanic Certificate with both Airframe and Powerplant ratings ('A&P'); Three years paid work experience in-field within the past seven years. Work experience must include the competencies, skills and knowledge levels included in the Aviation Maintenance Technology instructional programs. Excellent organizational, communication, and interpersonal skills.

**Preferred:** Associates, two-year, college degree (in field preferred); Post-Secondary Teaching experience preferred, curriculum development, and program recruitment experience in a two-year college environment. Excellent technology and classroom management skills.

**Physical demands:** Work is typically performed in a classroom/lab environment with the employee intermittently sitting, standing, walking, bending, pushing for three (3)—four (4) continuous hours at a time. The employee frequently lifts lightweight objects up to 50 LBS. The exposure to dirt, dust, grease, machinery with moving parts, chemicals and fumes is possible. The ability to speak clearly is required. The ability to hear and understand at a normal conversational level is required.
