POLICY:

The naming of buildings, facilities, grounds, and organizational units of technical colleges for individuals, businesses, or groups who have made significant contributions to society is an honored tradition of higher education. The prerogative and privilege of such names on the campuses of the Technical College System of Georgia are vested in the State Board.

RELATED AUTHORITY:

O.C.G.A. § 20-4-11 – Powers of the Board

O.C.G.A. § 20-4-14 – TCSG Powers and Duties

APPLICABILITY:

This policy applies to all buildings of the colleges governed by the State Board. It also applies to other facilities, grounds, and organizational units that the college wishes to dedicate in the name of individuals, businesses or groups. Buildings named for their general purpose or function, are not subject to this policy.
